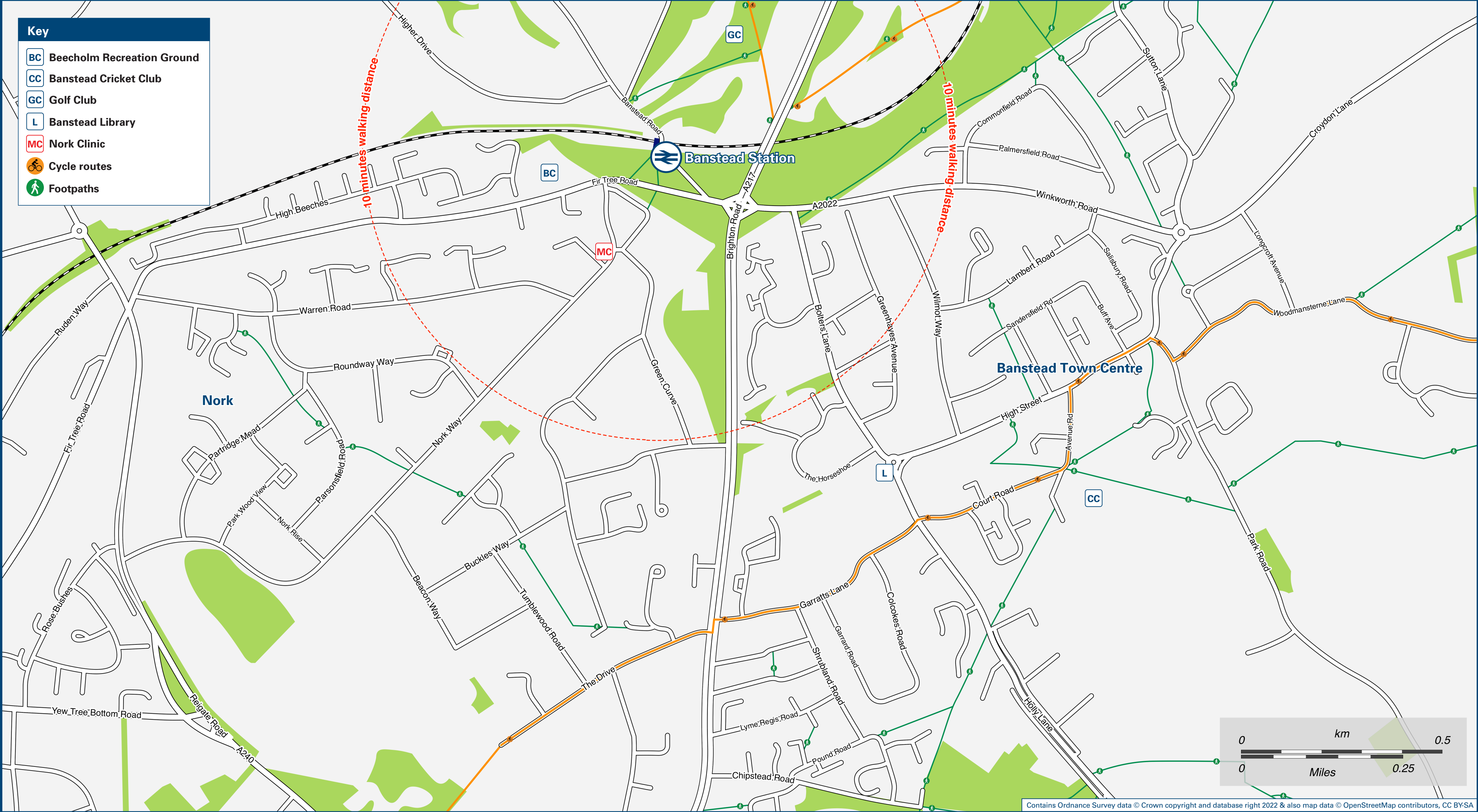

Notes

Bus route 166 operates from stops **A**, **B** & **C** on Mondays to Saturdays only (also daily from Banstead town centre / High Street towards Croydon).

Bus route 318 operates from stop **D** Mondays to Fridays only. Please note bus stop **D** has no bus stop pole & flag, it's located opposite Nork Way shops.
