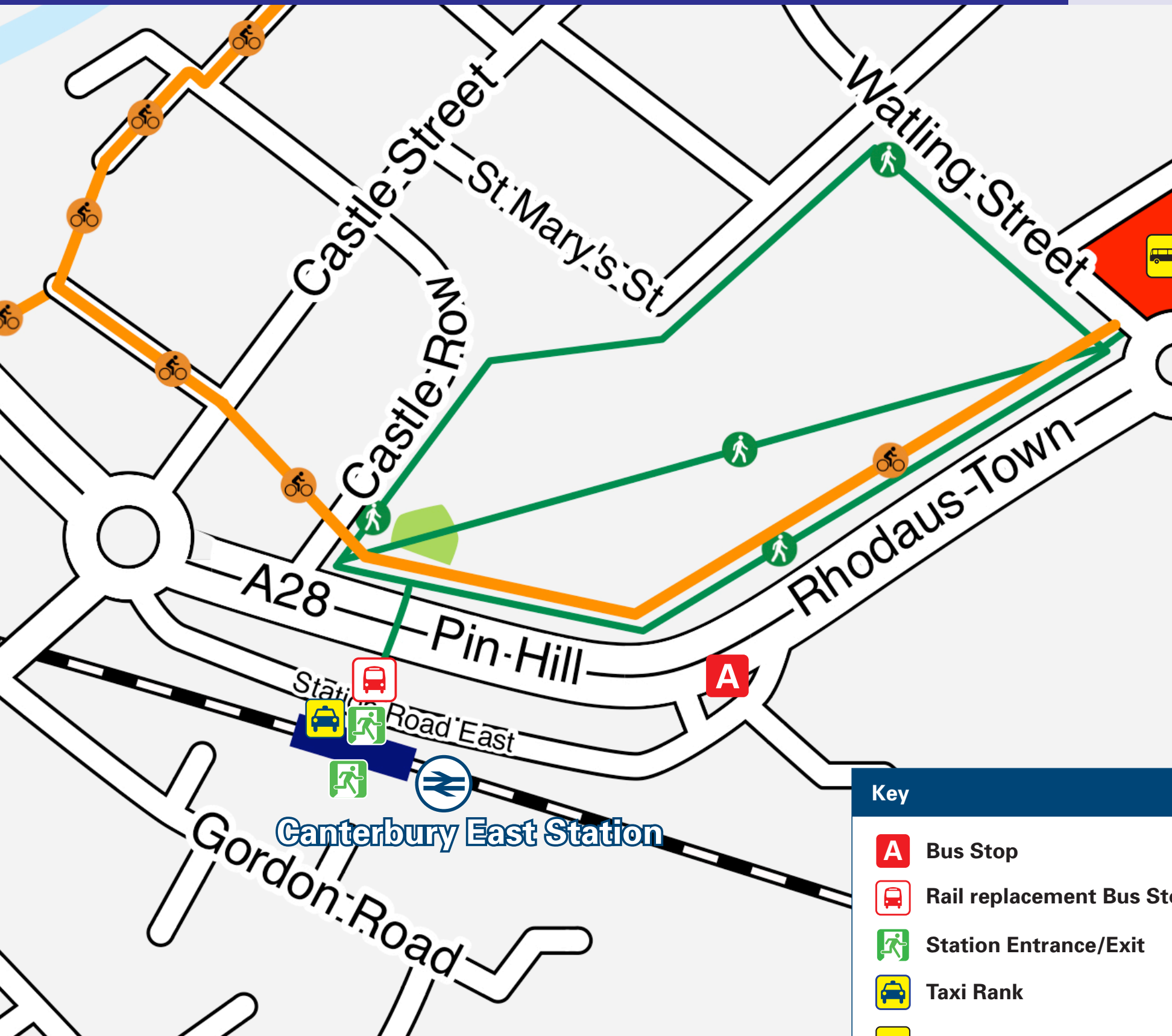

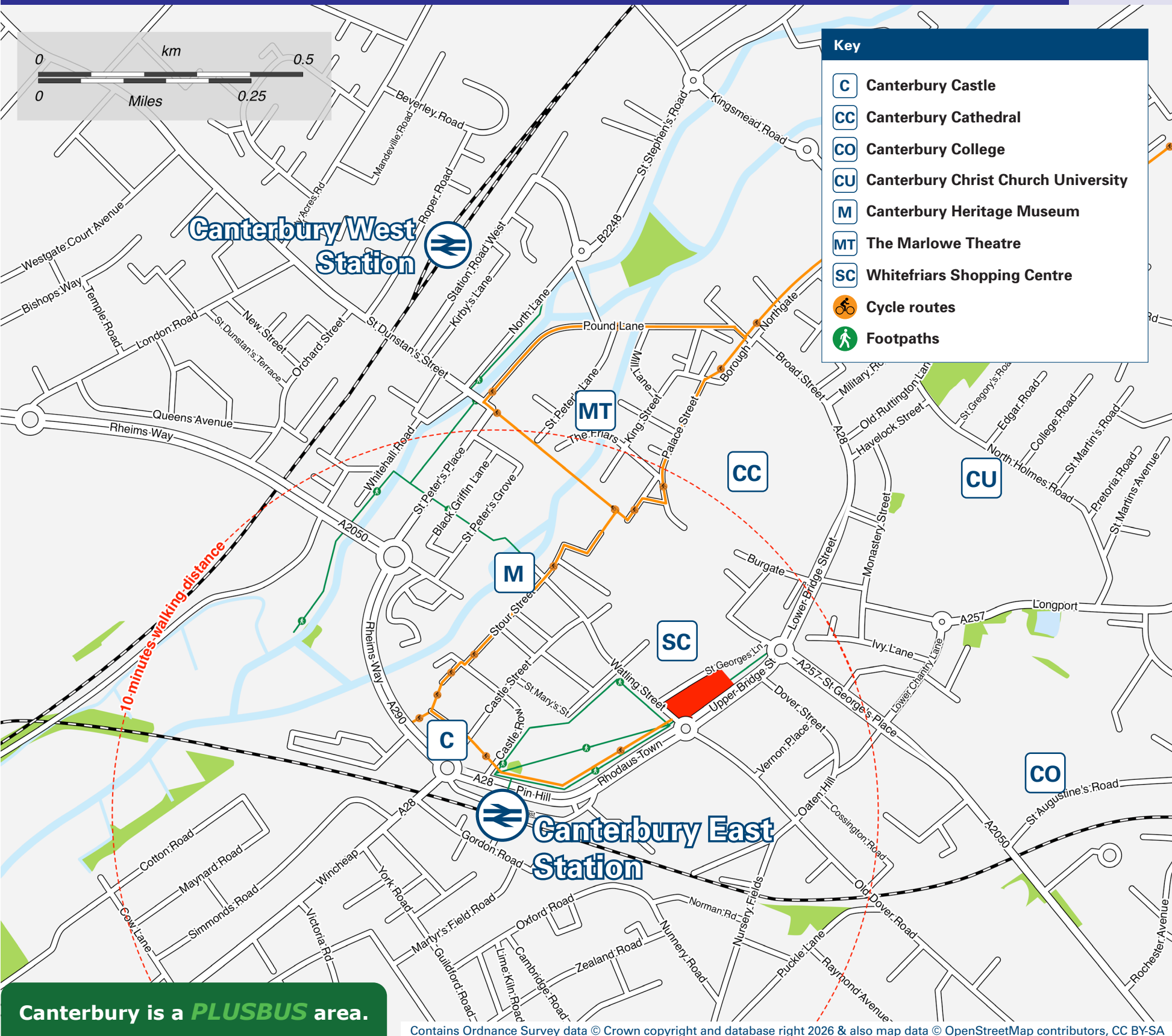


Key
